## Suffering & Comfort 1:1-11

Paul's afflictions lead to comfort for believers.



### PAUL'S INTEGRITY 1-7

He acted toward them with simplicity and sincerity.



### Absence 1:12-2:13

He didn't want his visit to cause pain.



### Ministry 2:14-7:4

His glorious ministry resides in jars of clay.



### Titus's Report 7:5-16

Titus reports the good response to Paul's letter.



### PAUL'S REQUEST 8-9

The expected contours of obedience are outlined for them.



### Collection 8-9

Paul comes to collect money for the Jerusalem church.



### PAUL'S DEFENSE 10-13

Those who reject Paul's ministry are now addressed with force.



### Authority 10:1-11

Paul will be bold; he tears down strongholds.



### Boasting 10:12-12:13

He is forced to boast in his strengths and weaknesses.



### Third Visit 12:14-21

He comes seeking their hearts, not money.



### Warning 13

Those who reject Paul will not be spared.
