## No Other Gospel 1:1-10

Paul chastises the Galatians for turning to another gospel.



## PAUL'S AUTHORITY 1-2

Paul's gospel was derived from God, not people.



## JUSTIFICATION 3-4

The Scriptures show justification comes by trust in Jesus' death.



## SPIRIT & FREEDOM 5-6

The Spirit grants them freedom to live in love.



## Divine Calling 1:11-24

Jesus appeared to Paul in light on the Damascus Road.



## Experience & Scripture 3:1-14

Abraham trusted God's promise of a multiethnic family.



## Slavery 5:1-12

Paul warns them not to submit to circumcision.



## The Pillars 2:1-10

Years later James, Peter, and John confirmed Paul's message.



## The Law 3:15-4:20

The law was temporary and imprisoned people under sin.



## Led by the Spirit 5:13-6:10

The Galatians need to keep in step with the Spirit, not the flesh.



## Rebuke of Peter 2:11-21

Paul even rebuked Peter with his gospel of justification by faith.



## Sarah & Hagar 4:21-31

They are children of Sarah (free), not Hagar (slave).



## New Creation 6:11-18

People are made righteous by faith, not works of the law.
