CHURCHES CAN LOOK DIFFERENT.



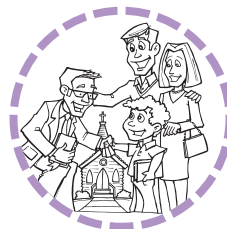
